Vhat's Filipino dialect for "How are you? The language is very similar to Spanish. The Philippines form a link between the americas of the Western World and the Far East. Their people are a mixture of asiatics (Chinese, Japanese, Mohammedan Morros etc) and white races (spanish Catholics and americans). The tilipino is not very tall and likes to call himself "the little american. The US is the only country which did not exploit its Far Eastern possessions. It brought in western civilization on an equality basis. As a result the natives are loyal and Jap propaganda never had a chance. After the defeat of Japan these islands will propably grow as prominent to asia as the British oldes are to Europe.
